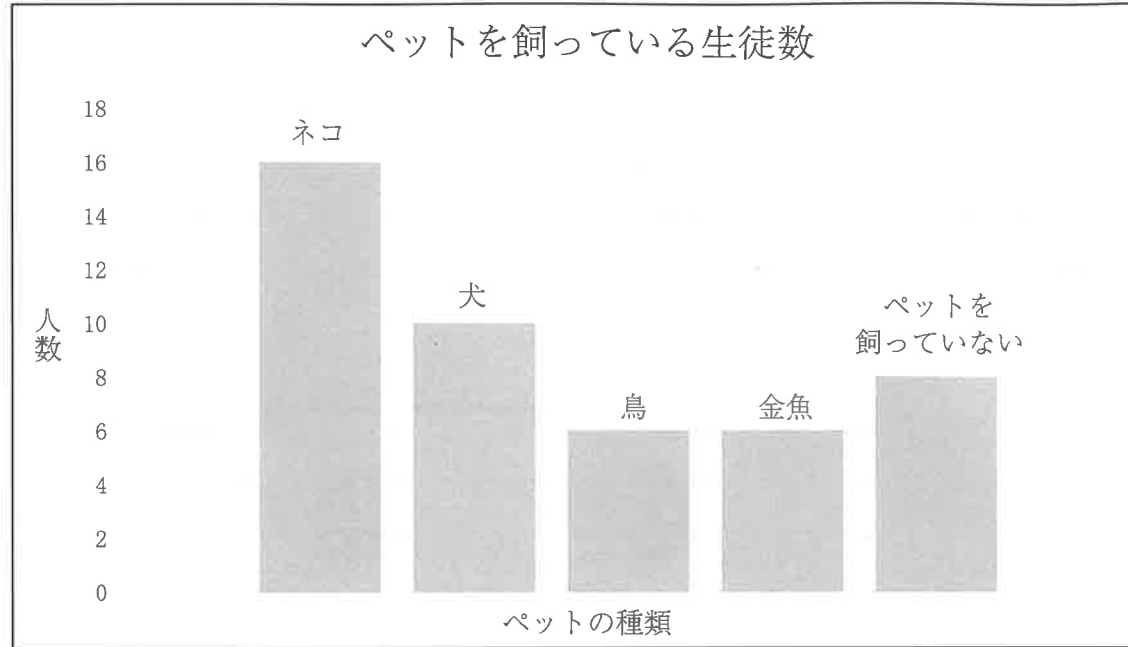

Do you like climbing mountains? ① (climbed / you / have / a mountain / ever) ? In Japan, more than nine million people climb mountains or go hiking every year, and the number of climbers is *increasing year by year. However, according to *National Police Agency, about 5000 people got in trouble last year while they were climbing mountains.

The Japanese company "Yamap" created a useful *app to find people who get lost in the mountains and to rescue *injured people. This app shows your location even when your phone can't be used or even if you are in a remote area.

Users download a map to their phone before going on a hike. Even if they can't make calls or use the Internet, ② they (see / where / on / can / are / they) the map. They can also share their *exact location with friends and family.

This company is asked for a lot of information for help from the police, rescue teams, and others. In 2022, they were asked for data related to 200 cases of *missing climbers. Many local police in places like Iwate, Miyagi, and Shizuoka have *cooperated with Yamap. This means they can quickly get information about people in trouble on mountains and help them faster in emergencies.

This app has become an important tool for finding and helping people in the mountains. It works even in places with no cellphone service, and more and more rescue teams and police are using it to save lives in emergency situations. It's a great example of how technology is making outdoor activities safer.
